This funding will be used to

- Provide access to quality resources for English, Mathematics and Science, including a levelled Reading Resource Room (L.Sharratt, Clarity).
- Improve student learning achievement in English (Writing – productive tasks) with 85% students achieving A-C by Semester 2, 2021.
- Continue to increase implementation of New Pedagogies, Deep Learning (NPDL) units in our NPDL champions classrooms, improving at least 50% student Effort (engagement and behaviour) in Science and Technologies (specialist teacher) by one effort rating. Build partnerships and opportunities for students to deepen their learning in science. Renew our Learning Environments and capacity to Leverage Digital including furnishing and facilities.
- Engage with families of children 0-5years of age to support early literacy and transition to school.

Our initiatives include


- Purchasing, sorting and storing resources for English, Mathematics and Science and library staffing to support demand.
- Engaging therapists (Occupational Therapy and Speech Language) to provide teacher training, support and additional intervention. Explicitly teaching vocabulary in Prep-year 6 classrooms.
- Refine and continue to enact a 4-year implementation plan for NPDL (M. Fullan, J. Quinn, J. McEchen). Deepening students learning in partnerships with Logan City Council, Impact Centre (online learning), Wonder of Science (Science ambassadors and staff professional development) and Solar Buddies (global partnership). Increasing student access to devices to enhance learning (iPads/trolleys/cases and laptop class set).
- Coordinating a school-based Play Group, Books for Bubs and Early Years events/programs to engage our community in the years prior to school.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchasing reading resources and reading room furnishings for storage (\$40 000).
- Providing teacher release to engage in Pedagogy, Planning and Assessment professional dialogue with Head of Department - Curriculum (\$50 000). Employing a vocabulary teacher for Prep – year 2 classes (\$19 000). Employing additional Teacher Aides for early and targeted intervention (\$61 122).
- Funding additional allocation of leadership focused on engagement, teaching and learning (\$90 000). Employing full time technician (\$40 000) Learning Environment Classroom Refurbishments (\$80 000). Partner with Impact Centre (\$10 000), Wonder of Science (\$3 500) and Logan City Council.
- Early Years Transition resource transition to school (\$5 000).
